This Privacy Policy sets forth the practices of Adventist Risk Management, Inc., an entity of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists (hereinafter referred to as “ARM”, “we”, “us”, and/or “our”) with respect to personal data (“Personally Identifiable Information” or “PII”) collected from individuals and entities, including but not limited to Unions, Conferences, Missions, Churches, Schools, Camps, hospitals, investigators, adjusters, and/or any other entity (collectively referred to herein as “Participating Organizations”) through various websites owned and operated by us and as a result of adjusting claims, accepting applications for insurance policies and maintaining mailing lists.
